Most significant activity this year was the installation of the 2 Boules pitches. Tremendous effort by the fundraising team for securing grants, putting on events and villagers for supporting.

Plans for constructing a hard standing area and accessible access to the Boules pitch along with some garden planting is currently being discussed. We continue to look at further fund raising events and activities we could support on the playing field.
