Dear Dana,

Just following up briefly following discussions around the A12 / Rendham / Saxmundham Junction. There are plans for additional lineage at the junction to alert traffic on the approach to the junction which it is hoped will improve awareness. There is also the suggestion of a possible roundabout to be installed linked to a proposal for a new garden suburb development adjacent to Saxmundham. This is by no means a confirmed approach but if this does move forward then that would help enormously in terms of traffic management and improved safety.

Regarding Friday Street, this is an ongoing set of works with traffic management in place while construction of the new roundabout goes in, and likewise at Yoxford.

The sudden change by the Govt to go ahead with elections in Suffolk will mean that there could be a change of administration which may have different ideas etc but we can't plan for that. The moratorium period will commence around the 20<sup>th</sup> March.

I will try and obtain more information for your next PC meeting.
